RECIPE'S (FROM POT LUCK / BIRTHDAY PARTIES)

Salted Nut Rolls

Mix: 1 box Yellow Cake Mix-1/4 c. butter-1 egg

Press into a 9x13 ungreased pan & bake at 350 until light golden brown (12 to 16 min.)

Pour: 3 c. miniature marshmallows (10oz pkg = 6 c.) on top & bake for 5 min. or until puffed up.

Melt: 10oz. peanut butter chips-1/2 c. butter-1/2 c. corn syrup over low heat until melted, then add 2 tsp. vanilla, 2c. Rice Krispies, and 2c. peanuts (12oz which is slightly more than 2c.). Mix & spread over marshmallows.

Refrigerate & cut into bars. Approx. 35 bars (1 3/4 x 1 3/4). as of 6/17. (See photo.)
