## RECIPE'S (FROM POT LUCK / BIRTHDAY PARTIES)

### **Perfect Pumpkin Pie**

- 2 - 15oz cans pumpkin
- 2 - 14oz cans sweetened condensed milk
- 4 - eggs
- 2 - tsp cinnamon
- 1 - tsp ginger
- 1 - tsp nutmeg
- 1 - tsp salt

With wire whisk, beat pumpkin, milk, eggs, spices and salt. Pour into 9 x 13 pan sprayed with Pam. Bake at 425 degrees for 15 minutes. Then reduce heat to 350 degrees and continue baking for 30 minutes or until knife inserted comes out clean. After pie has baked 30 minutes, take out and top with crumble topping:

- 1 - cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 - cup flour
- 1/2 - cup butter

Blend with pastry cutter until crumbly. Stir in 1/2 cup chopped nuts. Sprinkle over pumpkin and bake for 10 minutes longer.
